Keyless Access



Aperio is fully compatible with 125kHz proximity or 13.56MHz Mifare/DESFire technologies.

Easy Integration

Existing doors are easily equipped with Aperio locks, and at a much lower cost than traditional access controlled doors. The wire-free technology means there is no need to hardwire the building, avoiding complicated wiring or intrusive work. You can continue using your existing doors and mortise locks, making installation quick, simple and cost effective. And with all doors linked online, authorization is updated in real time, providing a high level of control and tracking.

How it Works

The user presents their credentials to the Aperio lock and the lock sends the relevant user information to the Aperio Hub, which in turn relays it to the Security Expert or SP-C-WEB controller. The controller makes a decision based on the configured access permissions, and the result is sent via the Aperio hub back to the lock, where the user is granted or denied access in real-time.



Licensing

Integration requires a Security Expert Aperio Wireless Door license for each connected wireless door.
